They are thankful to MHCC for teacher stipends this year for all their classrooms; There was no open house this year, but hopes to see it back on campus next year as well as the full return of classroom volunteers; Encouraged parents to speak with children later today about fire drill to further reinforce safety and ease any worries; Thank you to Mrs. McNeil for working so hard on our new Fall Bell Schedule.
Treasurer's Report Nicole Smith	Thank you to families who participated in Hawk Walk which brought in \$27,000! New expenses this month were for movie night, licensing for movie, setup company, 5th grade promotion, standard operating costs, & basic school supplies. Chromebooks will be purchased soon with money previously allocated for technology from last year; Noted that we try to spend as much of incoming money as possible each year. Any excess is budgeted for the next year or for gifts for the school; Kim will let us know about shade options for next year to help provide our students with more relief, possibly permanent shade options all over school; Extra Expenses were discussed during an executive board meeting. Discussed giving a stipend to our ELS teachers, Miss Adishian & Mrs. Swartz, for our Clubhouse and to our counselor, Mrs. Derry, for counseling and Lunch Bunch. We already award stipends to the teachers for Fall basic supplies. Amount is based on number of students per class. Teachers submit receipts for money spent.
