Principal's Report Mrs. McNeil	Senate Bill 328 regarding late start times for middle & high schools will cause changes in school starts times for the fall. Because Walnut Valley is a unified school district, the district will assess the impact and needs of all schools & district transportation schedules. The goal is for the least amount of change. Maple Hill sent two proposals to the district and is hoping for a start time of 15 minutes early or later than our current start time; New mask mandate email to be sent out by district late this week. Maple Hill will do a phone blast and incorporate into the Sunday Message that as change comes and we walk through the gate, no matter what our families choose, we are all still Hawks. We will use the power of choice to move forward in a positive way; Covid numbers are trending down. Volunteers will be welcomed back on campus for planned outdoor events like Spring Book Fair, 5th grade carnival, 5th grade promotion. Steps to volunteer include 1. Get cleared- signed volunteer form, photo ID, & negative TB test. 2. Fully Vaccinated Status. Once both steps have been completed please note that it will take 2 weeks minimum to receive clearance. Once cleared, volunteers will need complete a health screening after which they will enter the campus through the outdoor gates. Teachers will reach out as opportunities arise.
