<p>Treasurer's Report Nicole Smith</p>	<p>This year's overhead costs were approximately \$25,000. The excess all goes toward the kids; There are continuing invoices for Chromebooks, mice, and earphones. \$18,000 has been set aside & earmarked from this year's budget for this expense; 5th grade carnival is all prepped, ready, and stayed within budget. Thank you to an anonymous parent who donated the money for the food; Recycling goal was surpassed. We brought in over \$1,100. Thank you to all who participated; Upon inquiry regarding shade structures for the school, Mrs. McNeil shared that the representative from the district office walked the grounds with her and discussed shade locations and more cost efficient ways to shade using existing fencing rather than large shade structure. She is waiting for feedback & quote from the district office. Nicole stated that shade money will come out of this year's budget and she will need the quote by June 20 in time for our summer executive board budget meeting. We are not able to carry huge balances over to the following year's budget. This helps to ensure transparency; Mrs. Rovira asked Nicole to email her the names of any teachers who still need to turn in receipts for reimbursement.</p>
