Principal's Report Mrs. McNeil	Welcomed attendees and discussed student opportunities and safety: <u>Student Council</u> - 3rd-5th grade, meets biweekly, runs student store, flag duties, would love them to act as student ambassadors in January & February. They are a great group of students and are currently hosting a canned food drive; <u>Conflict Mediators</u> - 5th graders get trained in how to resolve conflicts. They really love helping the kids on the primary playground & the kids love them as well; <u>Morning Announcers</u> - Three times per week (T, W, & TH) to help keep kids informed, includes words of wisdom, announcements, special upcoming events, SEL, & a school-wide Pledge of Allegiance; <u>After School Choir</u> - 3rd-5th grade; <u>Math Olympiad</u> - Mrs. Criddle along with a team of 35. This Thursday is their first competition. Matching t-shirts & snacks will be made available through the Dedicated to Learning Grant; <u>Focus on Safety</u> - We are having drills practice: Fire, Lockdown, and Earthquake Drills, going slowly to answer questions and get routines down. There will be a Fire Drill at lunch without the teachers, only noon aides present. Then teachers will join at the conclusion of the drill. Teachers' Report Representative Mrs. Theresa Rovira	Mrs. McNeil delivered report for Mrs. Rovira who was not present. All classes had so much fun during their Fall parties. She shared pictures with attendees; MHCC Board members were asked to provide a photo with their child to Mrs. Cahalan; Asked if it is possible to get all the birthday signs for the year to teachers to get filled out and returned asap to MHCC. Nicole happily approved; Teachers wanted to share that they are feeling truly thankful for families and our school community this year. Nicole reciprocated the same gratitude on behalf of the families for our school staff.

Treasurer's Report Nicole Smith	Presented Balance Sheet and Profit & Loss Statement for July 1-November 15. Largest bills so far include t-shirt orders. Back stock was needed and new items added. MHCC covered deficits for t-shirts, etc. to encourage students to show their school spirit. Other regular expenses include laminating supplies and service & copier lease & maintenance. We lease copiers because they outdate quickly; Sign up for Amazon Smile with Maple Hill Elementary School Community Club as your charity of choice. It's completely free and they send our school money quarterly. Will post Amazon Smile reminders on MHCC Facebook page for parents; Recycling so far this year has brought in \$415. Goal is \$1,000. We accept water bottles, aluminum cans, and glass labeled with CRV. Bring in on Wednesday mornings by 8:30 and leave on the front lawn. No one will be there to collect, just drop & go; Discussion with Mrs. McNeil soon regarding \$14,000 funds available for technology.
1st V.P.'s Report Patti Beltran	Attended monthly Coordinating Council Meeting. Issues with meeting on zoom. Will give further report once minutes are obtained. Per Dr. Taylor from Nicole- Middle Schools offer vaccination clinics for students ages 5-11. 2nd shot available in 3 weeks. They are looking for another time to do a regular clinic for ages 12+ at the high school. Emphasized that vaccinations are not mandatory, they are just making it available. No mandates yet from the state either. Will keep us informed; Late Start Bill- In theory High School would not start before 8:30, Middle School not before 8 am. Every school will be impacted due to bus schedules. The Governor may or may not push it out a year when the bill gets signed in January. Goal is to have as little change as possible.
2nd VP's Report Julie Lagos	Fall Fundraiser wrapped up by picking up t-shirts on Friday. Will distribute prizes in 1-2 weeks; Family Night Outs have raised \$1200-1300 so far! Chick-Fil-A FNO raised \$413, Panda Express raised \$260, Yogurtland- Maple Hill is in the Lead. First place brings in \$300. Trying to plan for Friday Dec. 3 thank you back to teachers; Selling tickets for Skate Express when school resumes after Thanksgiving Break. Event will be fun for families and teachers.
