Teachers' Report Representative Mrs. Theresa Rovira	Expressed excitement to see all attendees. Thanks to MHCC for providing deli sandwiches for teachers who will eat together today & for providing \$ for class parties. The funds can be used on any party throughout the year & teachers will turn in receipts for reimbursements. Notes went home to parents regarding missing student sweatshirts from orders to inform that they will arrive soon; Confirmed that teachers may order MH logo sweatshirts and t-shirts all year long; Kids are looking great in their MH shirts on Fridays; Trimester 1 is wrapping up with district assessments; SEL is in full gear as behavior needs increased, while academics are still strong. Teachers miss parent helpers & will be happy when they can return to campus; Overall, students are happy to be back on campus, earning post-it notes & Otter Pops for PBIS behavior. Halls are buzzing with laughter. Recess continues in zones. Kids are loving playground equipment.

Treasurer's Report Nicole Smith	MHCC expenses usually include ordering t-shirts, copier maintenance, laminating supplies & service, & copier maintenance. This month money spent on large t-shirt order because we had no back stock. Back stock is needed as some teachers offer incentives for wearing school t-shirts in support of school spirit; Fall Fundraiser was so successful. Julie will elaborate in her report. We want to give back to the kids so we gave each teacher \$5 per student for any party of choice this school year. Teachers will turn in receipts. There are some Spelling City reimbursements on the way; Recycling is bringing in \$50-\$80 per load. Goal is \$1,000 for the school year. We accept water bottles, aluminum cans, and glass labeled with CRV. Bring in on Wednesday mornings by 8:30 and leave on the front lawn. No one will be there to collect, just drop & go. It will be picked up at 8:30.
1st V.P.'s Report Patti Beltran	Attended monthly Coordinating Council Meeting. Dr. Taylor reported that all schools have started dance, art, and music programs for this school year. COVID numbers are the lowest in our area, not just in our schools, but in our community. Transmission in our schools is not happening thanks to all who help to keep our schools and families safe; Great Shake Out is tomorrow; District Parent Symposium is this Sat at 10:30 am. YouTube link to be emailed to all families. Guest Speaker will be Dr. Eric Brackett. Separate tracks for educators & for parents. Yes on WV Bond has provided all schools with something. That is rare! 2nd VP's Report Julie Lagos	Congrats to Maple Hill Family for raising \$51,000, far exceeding the \$40,000 goal! A flyer will be coming home soon to parents with Tax ID info as well as info on how the funds will be spent; Official announcement pending regarding Fall Fundraiser class winners for most money earned (one class) as well as most participation (one upper & one lower grade class). 2 classes earned over \$5,000! Most classes had over 50% participation with 268 students bringing in over \$75 each. Natalie will confirm winners with Kendra & popsicle party date TBD; Chick Fil A fundraiser amount to be shared next meeting; Many restaurants are not yet ready to resume fundraisers; Winco made a \$500 donation to MHCC; 2nd shipment order of spirit wear arrives next week.
