Reading and Approval Minutes	Approved by Nicole Smith and Patty Beltran
President's Welcome Natalie Johnson	Thanked attendees for joining today's meeting. Presented meeting agenda and gave explanation of meeting order. Nothing new to report.
Principal's Report Mrs. McNeil	Welcomed attendees and presented new district modified COVID-19 close contact quarantine protocols: Positive case will continue to be subject to full 10-day home isolation quarantine regardless of vaccine status or mask wearing. Unvaccinated close contact student will have 2 new options: 1. If showing no symptoms the student may stay in class provided they test twice during the quarantine period OR 2. Stay home for 10 days & perform test on day 6 & return on day 8 with a negative test result. BUT during the 10-day period the unvaccinated close contact may not participate in extracurricular activities such as Math Olympiad or Choir; Parking lot barriers have been added to ensure lot safety & ensure enough parking for school staff. Notes are being placed on cars to educate any who are not complying with our school parking rules; Principal Awards Assembly went really well; Teachers have been gathering data & making informed decisions for students. One of the ways they prepare for each student is by having 1 to1 data talks with other staff members.
Teachers' Report Representative Mrs. Theresa Rovira	Expressed excitement to see all attendees. Teachers and staff are looking at academics & data; Students are thriving and working on SEL; Staff meeting focus was on the playground which now has 6 aides, 1 counselor, & Mrs. McNeil out monitoring. Students continue to play in zones; Drama & music in the small MPR have begun with students able to socially distance & the large MPR now has two new air filters so the staff feels safe. Students will be able to practice computer skills again with a new teacher in about a month. The teachers miss parent volunteers but are so grateful that support staff is able to step in and help take on that load; Thank you to all parents who have supported the Fall Fundraiser.
Treasurer's Report Nicole Smith	T-shirt order was placed for all orders and should arrive in a week or so; Fall Fundraiser is going well. Julie will elaborate in her report. No major expenses except printing & t-shirts.

1st V.P.'s Report Patti Beltran	Attended Coordinating Council Meeting. Attendees introduced themselves and their school. WVEF provided schools with a Chick-fil-A Free Item card for each student. They will be dispersed in conjunction with a flyer to the October Fundraiser at Chick-fil-A.
2nd VP's Report Julie Lagos	Mr. G.'s Family Night Out was successful. Maple Hill earned \$600. Next FNO will be October 5 at Chick-fil-A in the City of Industry. Flier to be sent home on 10/4 along with a free item card to encourage participation; Fall Fundraiser goal was \$40,000. As of 9/22/21 we are at approx. \$37,500. An addition flyer will be sent out tomorrow. Popsicle parties incentive for top earning class, & most participation- 1 upper and 1 lower grade classroom.
